Sub:- Admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in existing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats at Jay Jalaram Homoeopathic Medical College, at & Post Morva (Rena) , Taluka Shahera, Distt. Panchamaharal – 389001, Maharashtra – regd.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry’s policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the documents submitted by the college authority for the admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats at **Jay Jalaram Homoeopathic Medical College, at & Post Morva (Rena) , Taluka Shahera, Distt. Panchamaharal – 389001, Maharashtra**, and furnished recommendation vide its letter No. F. No. 15-8/2020-CCH (Visitation Matter) 3062 dated 12.10.2020 as under:-

"Recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 100 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course.

The Committee also recommended to apprise the Ministry that the college has not complied with the provisions of Employee’s Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations”

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, conditional **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Jay Jalaram Homoeopathic Medical College, at & Post Morva (Rena) , Taluka Shahera, Distt. Panchamaharal, Maharashtra for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of 100 seats, with the condition to fulfil all deficiencies as reflected at para 1 within 31st December, 2020 from date of issue of this letter.**

3. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counselling for seats

under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government vide letter F. No. L. 11011/02/2020-E-(1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

5. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

6. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.

7. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2020 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2021-22 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
