Sub: Application for Letter of permission for functioning of Jay Jalaram Homoeopathic Medical College, At & Post Morva – Rena, Taluka: Shaher, Dist: Panchamahals, Morva, Gujarat – 389002 for admission with intake capacity of 100 seats for conducting Undergraduate (BHMS) course for the academic year 2023- 24– reg

Sir,

Jay Jalaram Homoeopathic Medical College, Morva, Gujarat has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2023-24. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH has conducted the Inspection of college on 06.05.2023, followed by hearing on 31.5.2023 to start new post graduate course in M.D.(Hom.). MARB has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standard requirements to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020. As per the observations made by MARBH, following lacunae are to be rectified with immediate effect. College shall fulfil all functional requirements as per the Minimum Standard requirements.

A. Teaching Faculty: Total available teaching faculty is 40.

- No Professor in department of Repertory.
- No higher faculty in Surgery.

B. Collegiate Hospital:

- Case records should be well maintained in respect of case analysis, evaluation and repertorization and made available in Medical Records Room for academic purpose of students and follow up attendance of patients. Diagnosis should be written in ICD 11 criteria.
- College is not maintaining manual central register. Dispensing register was available but medicines were not mentioned in register.
- No manual register for IPD was maintained. While interrogating with the duty medical officer, she was not aware of the doctor who admitted the patient, patient details such as Demographics, diagnosis, medicines and admitted doctor etc. Some patients were not

even having their case records, thus the genuinity of the patients admitted in the IPD could not be ascertained.

- d) At the time of virtual hearing, no dispenser was available at the pharmacy. No manual dispensing register available. Computerised dispensing register does not contain name of medicines given.
- e) X-ray records were not maintained with required information. AERB license was not available, old non-functional X-ray machine was available, dark room was filled with cartons about which the x-ray technician was not aware of. Clinical laboratory, X-ray, sonology department is not functional.
- f) The OPD/IPD data provided by the college during the virtual & physical inspection is not correlating as per verification of the CCTV footage. Therefore, it is concluded that OPD/IPD data is manipulated.

C. Miscellaneous:


- a) Biometric attendance system is not functional and the college was not able to take printout of the same.
- b) Website is not functional/updated.

Considering the above observations, and facilities available, MARB has decided to issue **conditional permission to Jay Jalaram Homoeopathic Medical College, Morva, Gujarat for (BHMS) course for the academic year 2023- 24 with intake capacity of 100 seats.** All shortfalls mentioned shall be rectified within a period of 30 days or before counseling initiates whichever earlier, and compliance report shall be submitted to the undersigned, failing which the conditional permission issued will be withdrawn without further notice.

All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/ UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85 % seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the central govt for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.


The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
